

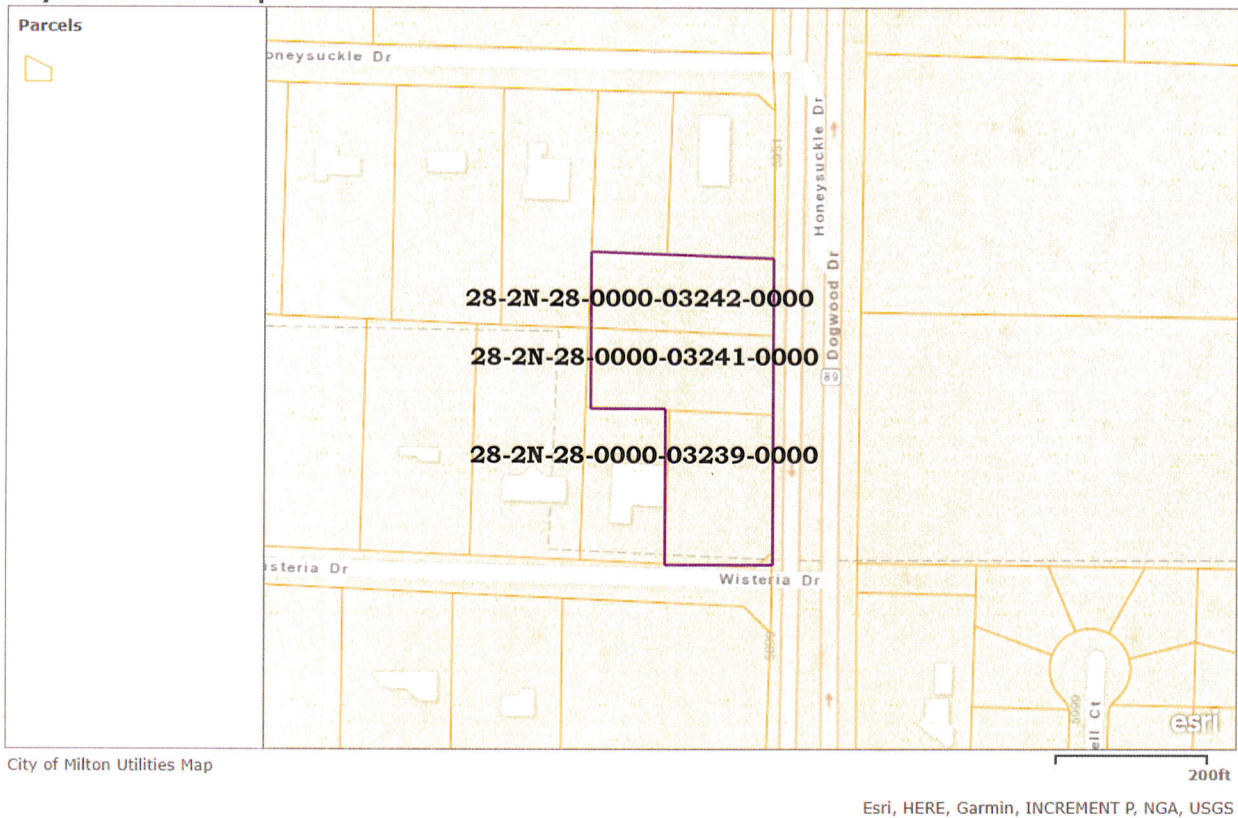
PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE
NOTICE OF REZONING AND FUTURE LAND USE MAP
AMENDMENT

This letter serves as notice that Gregory L. Mooney, owner of the three subject properties shown below, proposes to change the zoning and future land use classification of the land that is otherwise known as the following Parcel Numbers below:

Parcels 28-2N-28-0000-03239-0000, 28-2N-28-0000-03241-0000, and 28-2N-28-0000-03242-0000.

These properties within the city limits of Milton are shown on the map below. The purpose of this request is to change the zoning classification from R-1AA (Low Density Residential, Single Family Zoning District) to R-3 (Residential, Multi-Family Zoning District) zoning for the purposes of a multi-family development.

The purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive comments and make decisions regarding the above matter.
